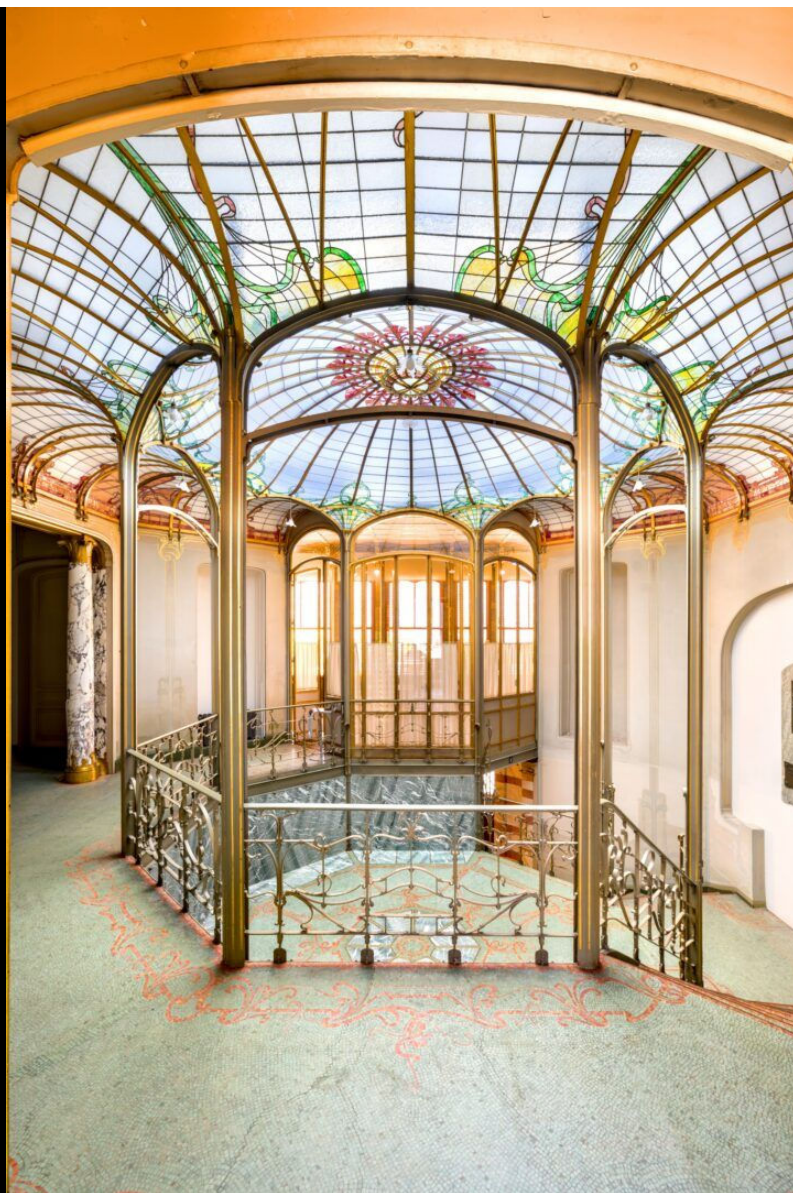

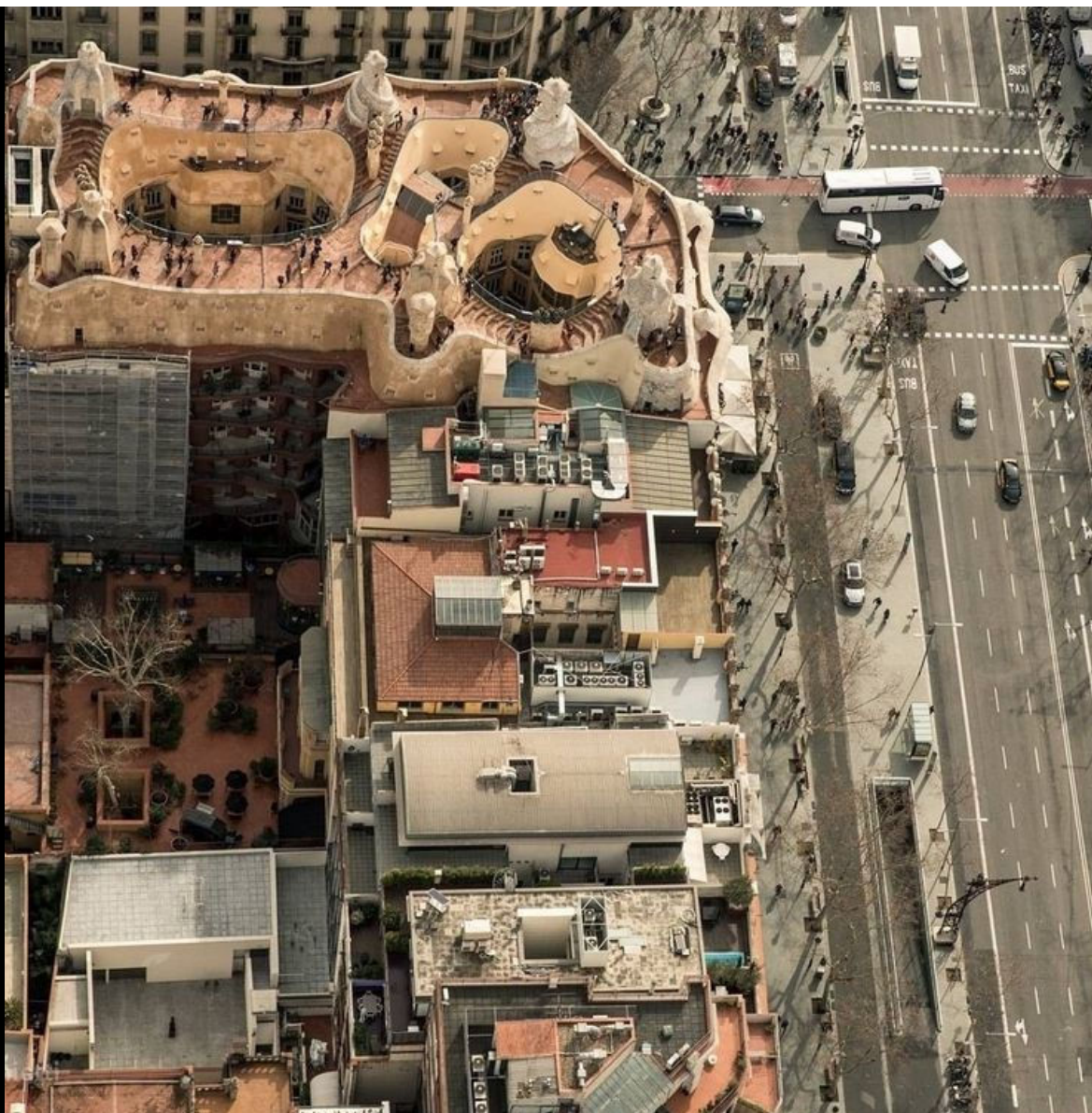
Plantas del 1ro al 5to

El interior está diseñado de forma muy suelta y libre, de la misma manera que su envolvente.



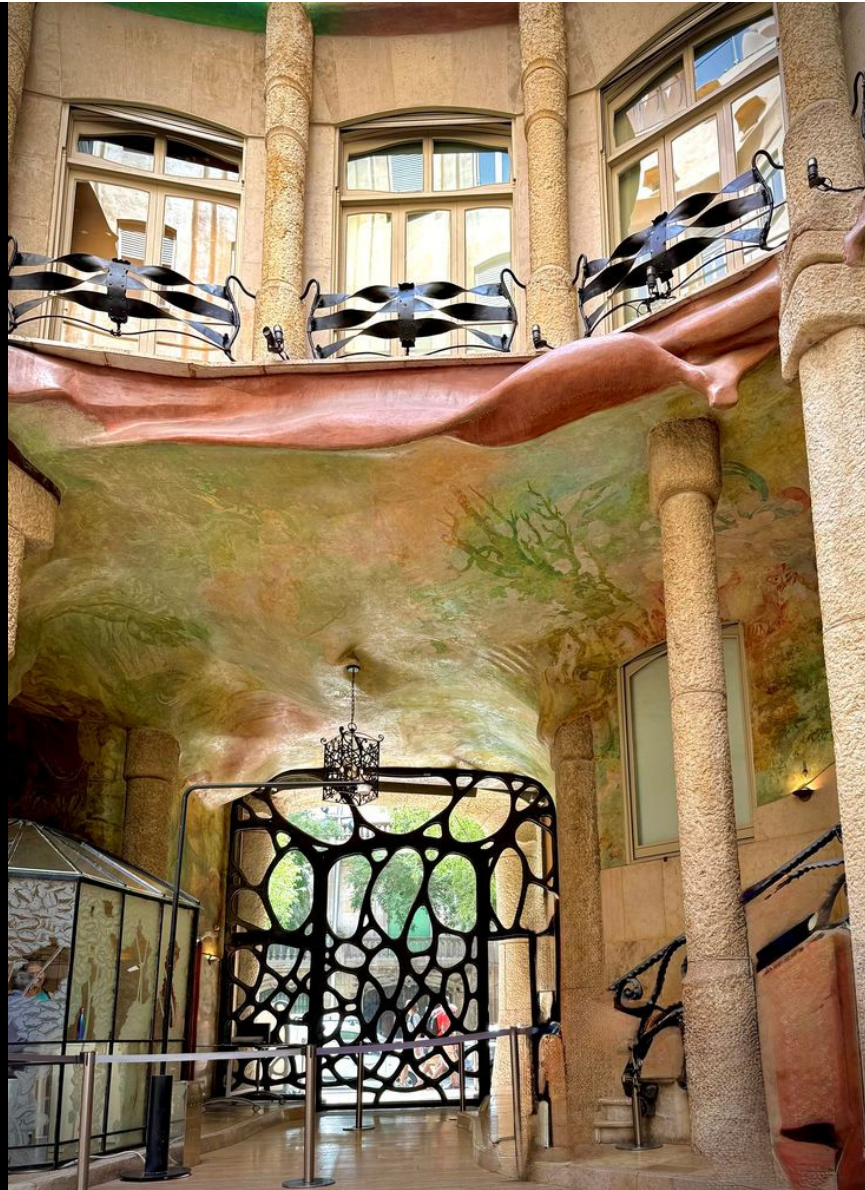
Planta Baja







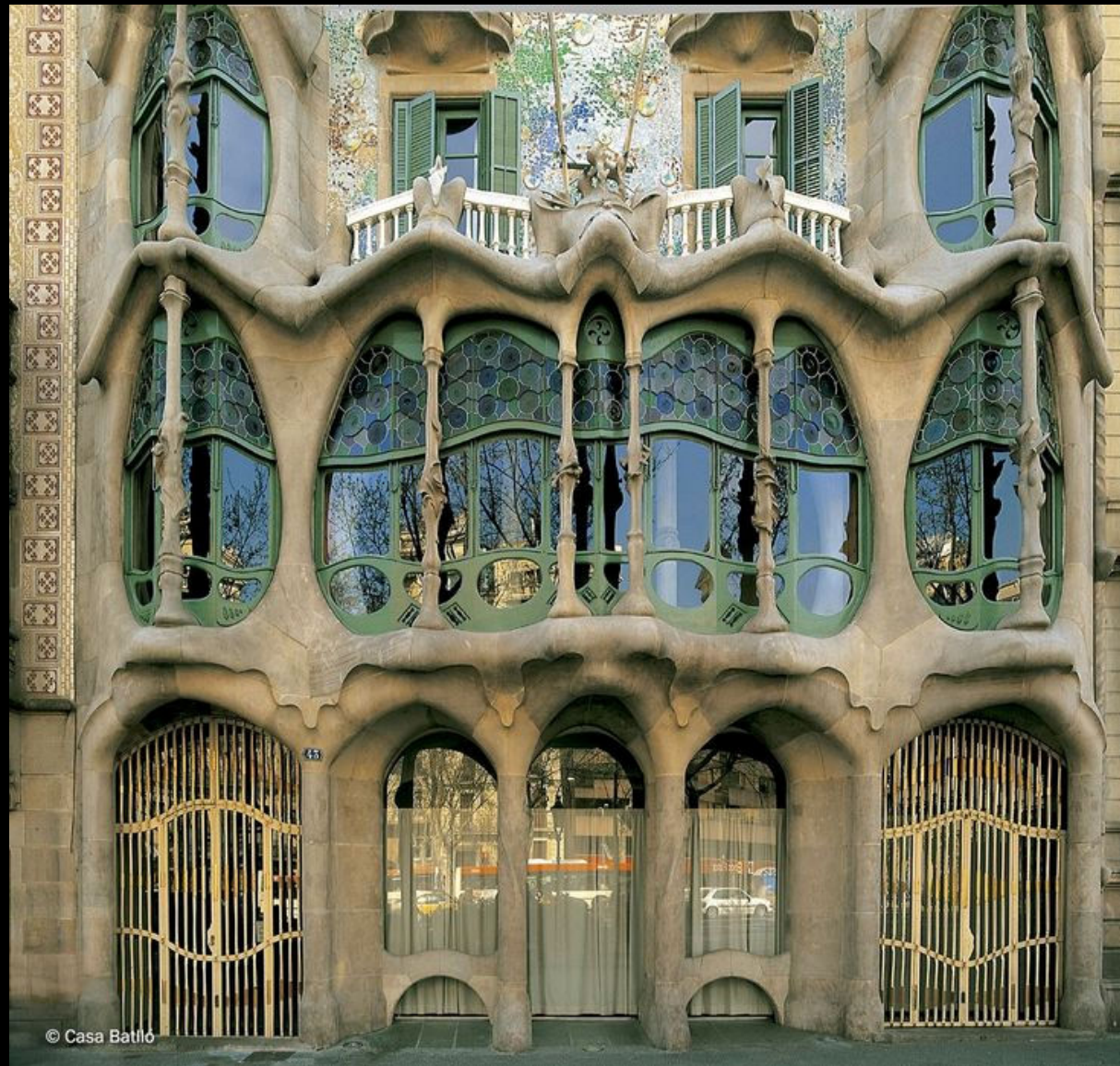

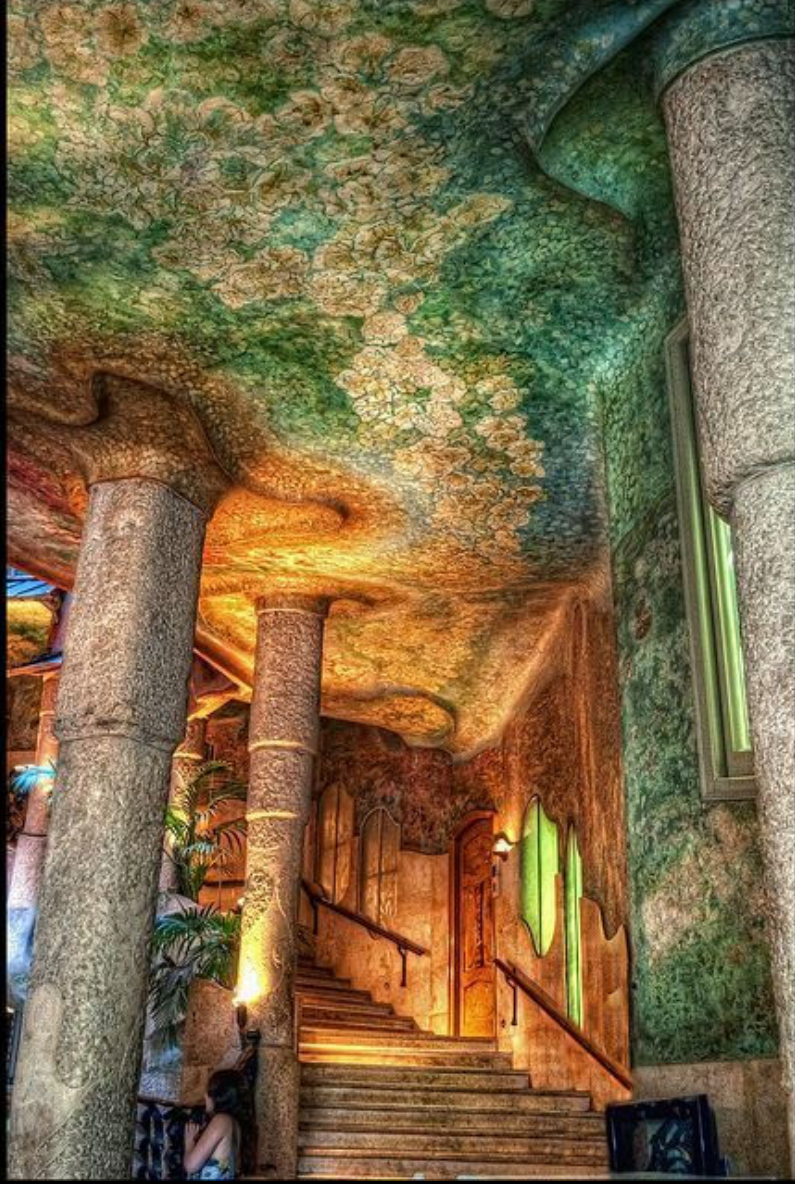

CUIDEMOS DEL PARQUE GÜELL

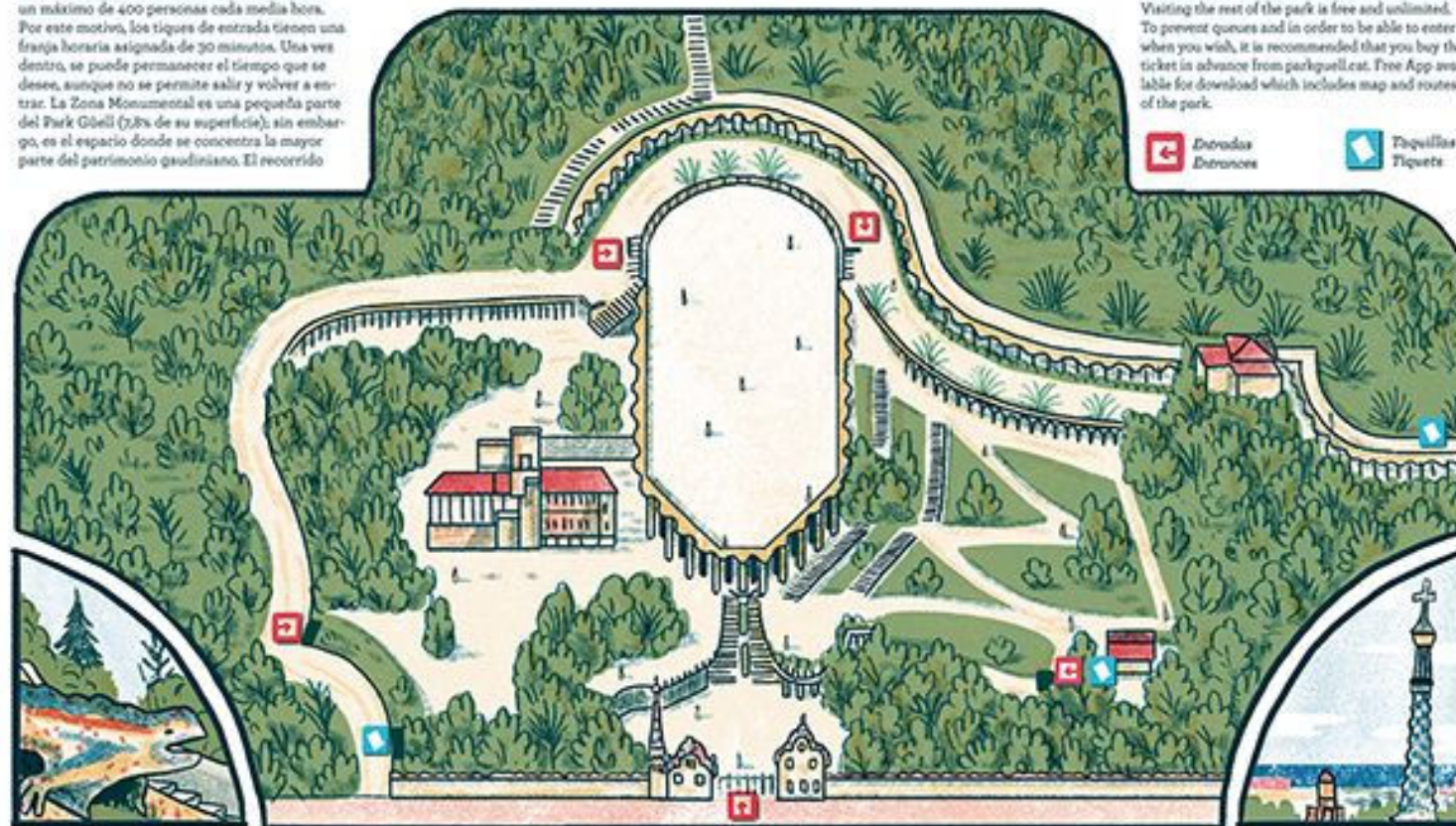
La alta masificación y afluencia de visitantes estaba degradando la zona monumental del Parque Güell. La gran obra de Gaudí estaba en peligro. Por eso, el Ayuntamiento de Barcelona decidió controlar el número de visitantes al parque y preservar así este patrimonio de la Unesco. Desde hace unos meses, se regula la entrada a un máximo de 400 personas cada media hora. Por este motivo, los tickets de entrada tienen una franja horaria asignada de 30 minutos. Una vez dentro, se puede permanecer el tiempo que se desee, aunque no se permite salir y volver a entrar. La Zona Monumental es una pequeña parte del Park Güell (7,8% de su superficie); sin embargo, es el espacio donde se concentra la mayor parte del patrimonio gaudiniano. El recorrido

por el resto del parque es libre y gratuito. Para evitar colas y acceder al parque a la hora deseada se recomienda la compra de entrada online en parkguell.cat. Disponible App gratuita con mapas y rutas del parque.

LOOKING AFTER PARK GÜELL

Mass tourism and increasing numbers of visitors were damaging the monumental area of Park Güell. Gaudí's great work was in danger. So Barcelona City Council has decided to control the number of visitors to the park and preserve this UNESCO heritage site. Since a few months ago, entrance has been limited

to a maximum of 400 people every half hour. For this reason, the tickets have a time slot of 30 minutes. Once you are inside you can stay for as long as you want, although you cannot leave and enter again. The Monumental Area is a small part of Park Güell (7.8% of its area); however this is the area where most of Gaudí's work in the park is concentrated. Visiting the rest of the park is free and unlimited. To prevent queues and in order to be able to enter when you wish, it is recommended that you buy the ticket in advance from parkguell.cat. Free App available for download which includes map and routes of the park.

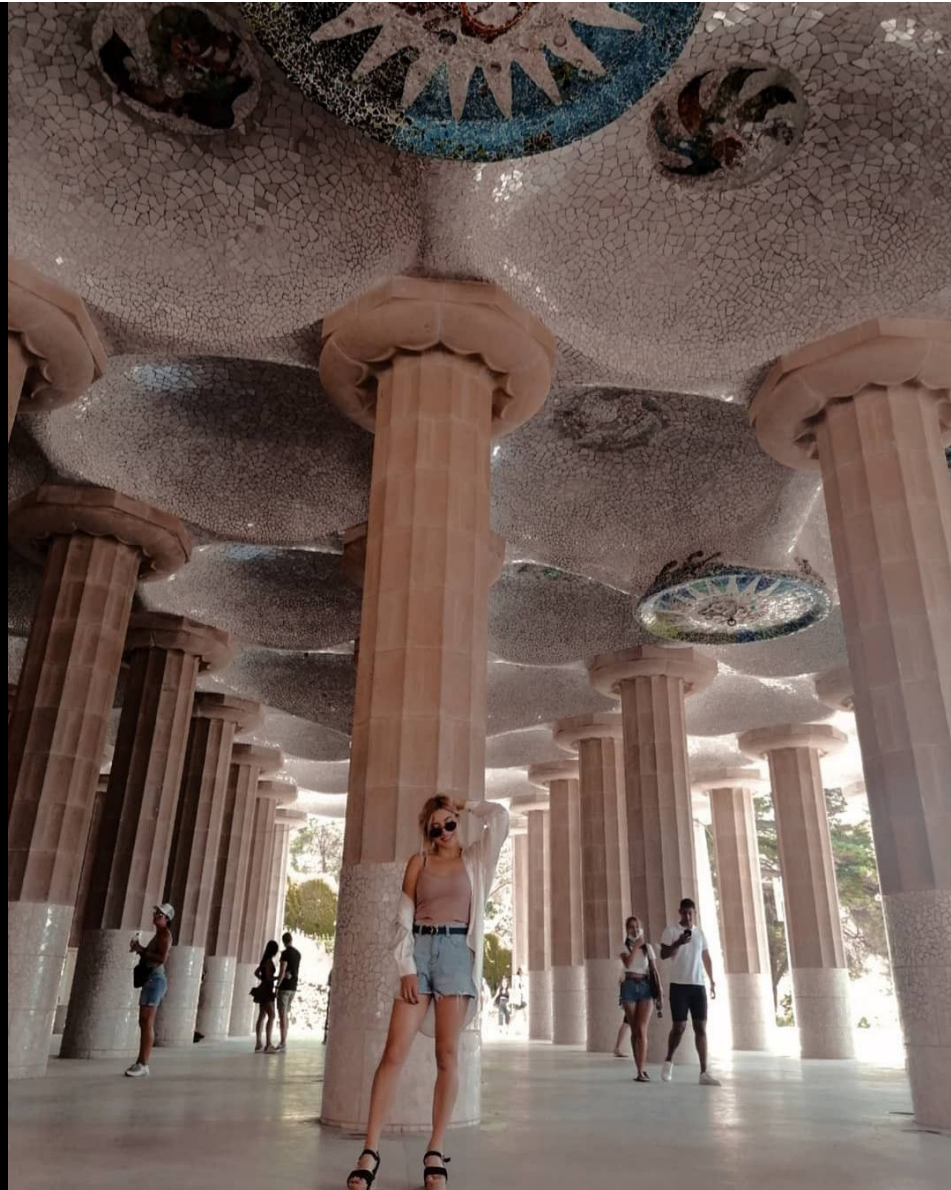
